## ***“Additional Readings for the Week”***

Mon.	Rom. 1:1-4	Even when we don't see God moving in our lives, we need to believe God is weaving promises into fulfillment.
Tues.	Rom. 1:5-7	Obey God not to earn his approval, but because we trust Him. Let faith lead and obedience follow.
Wed.	Rom. 1:8-9	We should lift people before God not just when they are in crisis, but as a rhythm of love. let your prayer life be an overflow of compassion, not a checklist.
Thurs.	Rom. 1:10-13	Live with a heart that seeks God's timing
Fri.	Rom. 1:14-15	remember that the gospel entrusted to me is meant to flow through me, not just to me.
Sat.	Rom. 1:16-17	We are to live unashamed of the Gospel,. Seek those moments to speak of the goodness of the Lord.
