“Additional Readings for the Week”

Mon.	Rom. 1:24-25	God does not force rebellion; He permits it. Judgment here is God allowing people to fully pursue what they insist on wanting.
Tues.	Rom. 1:26-27	God removes our restraint, allowing people to fully pursue desires that have already turned away from Him.
Wed.	Rom. 1:28-31	A “debased mind” is a mind that no longer functions according to God’s truth, It is spiritual disorientation.
Thurs.	Rom. 1:32	Paul’s point is not ignorance—it’s willful neglect. The issue is we know better, but don’t do better.
Fri.	Gen. 6:5-6	Genesis says God saw that “every intention of the thoughts of the heart was only evil continually.” The issue wasn’t just behavior—it was internal orientation.
Sat.	Prov. 1:29-31	As people If faith we need to nurture a heart that desires God’s ways. To practice prompt obedience, not delayed obedience.

Point to Ponder: When people reject God’s truth and glory, God allows them to follow their chosen path, and the result is the progressive distortion of desire, thinking, and behavior—leading to personal, relational, and societal breakdown.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, keep my heart from drifting away from your truth. Hold me close so I never settle for anything less than you, n Jesus name Amen
